What is the project about?

The project "The Career Garden" offers a virtual insight into the world of work including practical tasks to do at home. 8 partners in 5 countries are working together with companies to develop modules for starting an internship, which students in vocational or general education schools can use for career orientation. The online modules can be accessed via a web platform. Due to a multilingual approach, the modules are also interesting for foreign language learning. With these modules, young people are given the opportunity to grow into the world of work and gain

initial experience in different occupations, even if they cannot be on site.

Pupils, students, trainees, teachers and companies from the following five sectors benefit from this project: IT, medicine, crafts and construction, hotel and catering as well as the educational sector. The results of the project have model character. An expansion to other sectors is planned.

What do we mean by a virtual insight into the world of work?

30 multilingual online modules are developed with different elements, such as interviews, a virtual tour of the company, research tasks, e-learning sequences, quizzes and practical tasks that students can try at home. The companies develop their own virtual modules with us using these predefined elements, but contribute their experience, expertise and ideas to make it a perfect fit. The modules do not lead to passively watching videos. On the contrary, they are intended to provide guidance for practical work and to motivate young people to try out and learn new things.
