

Notes for teachers

The pre-internships on this website support students in the process of vocational orientation. The modules can either be tried out by them on their own at home or used on project days at schools. Even when used at schools, the basic principle remains "independent work". Everyone should be able to explore crafts and careers at their own pace.

It is recommended to provide sufficient space. Students need access to the Internet and the ability to write texts on the computer in addition to a workstation where they can do crafts. A list of the materials needed for the painting work can be found in the introduction to the module. Possibly the company Heinrich Schmid can contribute some materials. Contacting the company may be helpful for preparation.

Students will benefit most if they follow the designated sequence, completing the tasks under the 6 numbered boxes one at a time.
