Step 1

Remove the box from its packaging.

Step 2

Assemble box according to the instructions.

Step 3

Apply primer to all surfaces of the box.

Step 4

Choose the basic colour of the box.



Step 5

Paint the outer surfaces of the box with the selected colour.

Step 6

Paint the seat with a different colour.



Step 7

Arbitrary shaping of the seat surface by masking ("in this case a change of shape").

Step 8

Remove the masking tape.



Step 9

Glue any square on the opposite surface of the handle.



Step 10

Divide the square in the middle with another adhesive strip.

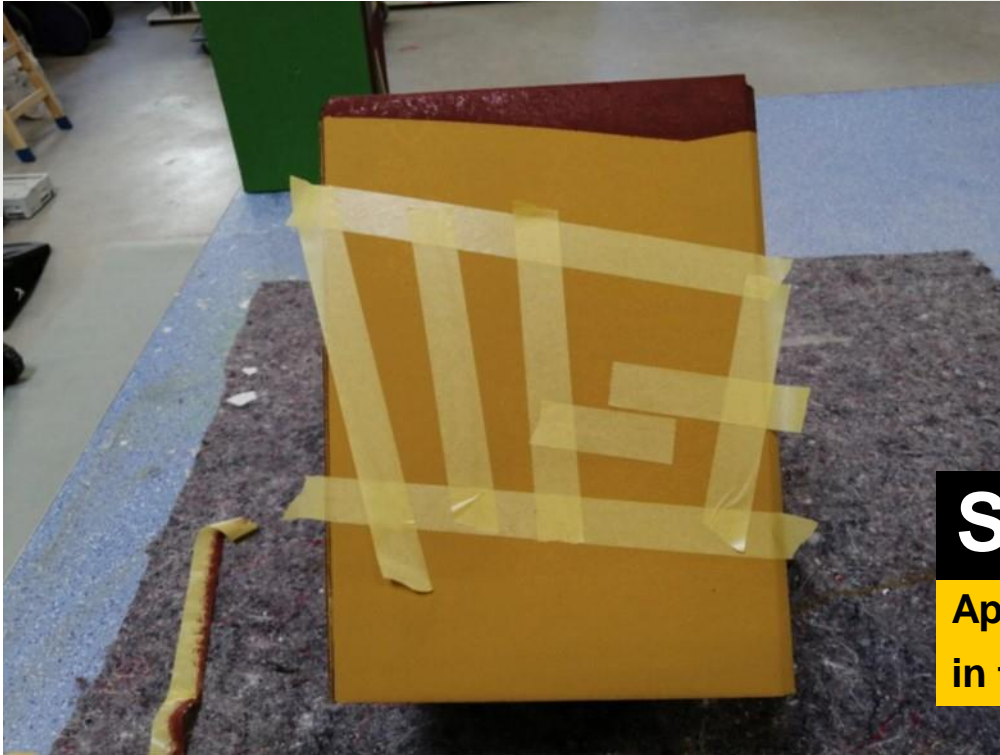

Step 11

Divide the left half of the square again with masking tape.



Step 12

**Apply masking tape as shown
in the photo.**

Step 13

Produce letters "H" and "S" with cuts (or your choice of letters) using a cutter knife.

Apply the colour of the seat to the letters.

Remove the masking tape.

Step 16

Fill large, free areas with shapes by taping them off.

Step 17

**Inspect box, be proud of it
and take it home.**



List of what is needed

- **Splash guard (e.g. foil, old bed linen, towels etc.)**
- **Cardboard stool (e.g. above www.karton.eu)**
- **masking tape**
- **paint roller**
- **possibly a brush**
- **Adhesive primer (e.g. Brillux ELF 3720)**
- **Full-tone tinting paint (e.g. Pufas, May green)**
- **Good mood**
